Conference Registration: Conference registration information for ICRA 2015 can be found at the [conference website](#). Challenge participants have two options with regard to registration:

* Full conference registration, which costs \$350/\$720 for IEEE member student/non-student. This covers attendance of the conference technical sessions and all receptions/banquets.

* Exhibit-Only registration, which costs \$200 and covers only the exhibitor and challenge areas. Exhibit registrants can also choose to purchase banquet tickets at an additional cost.

For the competition, please make sure that the trajectories and landmark features of your arenas are clearly visible with high contrast to the surrounding area under an epi-illuminated white light microscope. If we cannot see the landmarks clearly, we will not be able to evaluate your robot's performance.

We will send out more logistical information on the competition as it becomes available.
